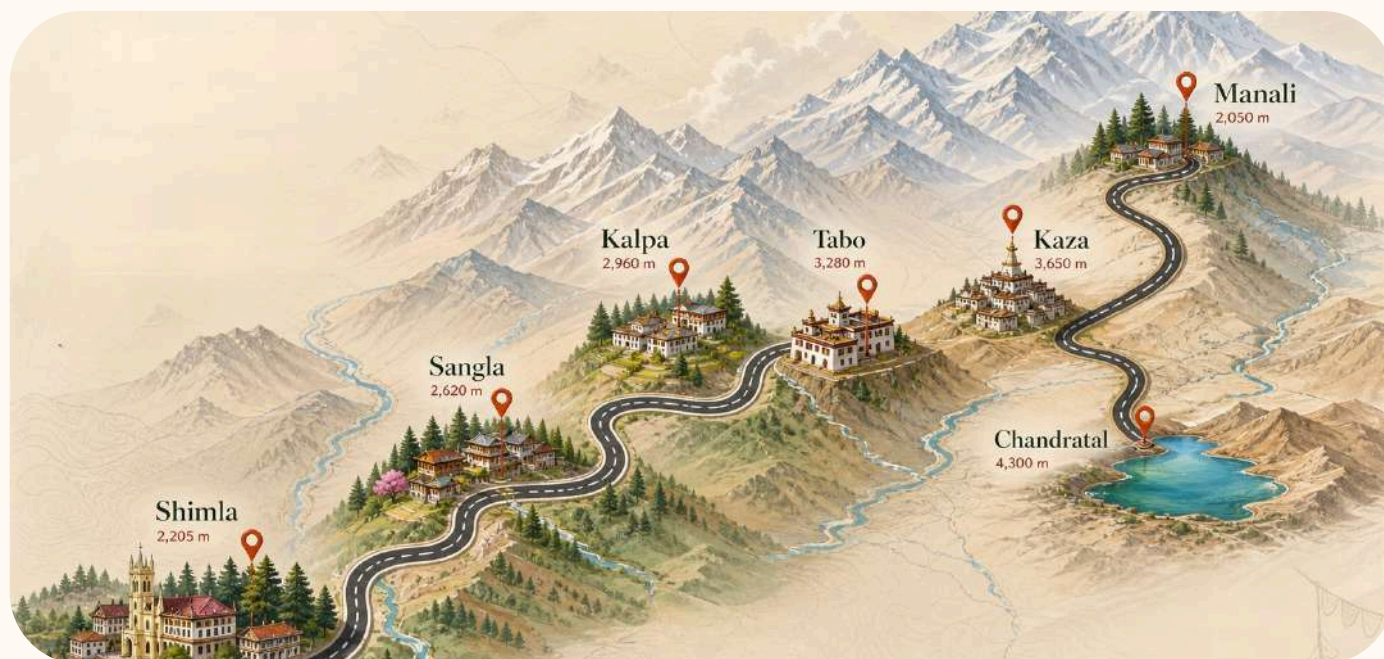

Shimla Entry For Gradual Acclimatisation

We enter through Kinnaur instead of rushing to high altitude. Your body adjusts gradually from Shimla (2,200m) through Sangla and Kalpa before reaching Kaza and the higher parts of Spiti.

Two Nights In Kaza For Breathing Room

Kaza is the base of Spiti. Two nights here give you time to explore the high villages comfortably, rest, enjoy the cafes and recharge before the Chandratol leg.

Manali Exit Completes The Full Loop

Instead of backtracking the same road, you exit via Kunzum Pass and Manali. Completely different landscapes on the return. No repeated views, no wasted time.

Chandratol Is Condition Based. Safety First.

Chandratol depends on road, weather and camp space. If Chandratol camping or access is unavailable due to weather, road safety, camp capacity or operational restrictions, the stay will be shifted to Losar. The Chandratol visit will remain subject to safe access.

DETAILED DAY-WISE ITINERARY



DAY 01

Delhi To Shimla (Overnight Volvo)

The night we leave the city behind.

- Board your overnight Volvo from Delhi in the evening
- Pickup: Delhi ISBT / Designated Pickup Point (approx. 6 to 7 PM)
- Settle in and rest as the bus rolls through the night towards the hills

Highlight: Your Spiti journey begins tonight



DAY 02

Shimla To Sangla Via Kinnaur Gate

The first big mountain drive. Kinnaur unfolds.

260 km | 9 to 10 hrs

- Arrive in Shimla and meet your group and trip captain/coordinator.
- Drive via Narkanda and Rampur
- Stop at Kinnaur Gate, then continue along the Sutlej Valley.
- Lunch en route (pay directly). Continue deeper into Kinnaur.
- Reach Sangla by evening for dinner and overnight.

Overnight: Sangla | Meals: Dinner

Highlight: Kinnaur Gate and the first deep Sutlej Valley views

**DAY 03****Sangla To Chitkul, Roghi & Kalpa**

India's last village and the Kinnaur Kailash backdrop.

95 km | 5 to 6 hrs

- Drive to Chitkul, the last village on the old Indo-Tibet road
- Explore the Baspa Valley. Walk through the village.
- Drive to Kalpa via Reckong Peo
- Visit Roghi Village and Suicide Point; enjoy Kinner Kailash views (weather permitting)

Overnight: Kalpa | Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

Highlight: Chitkul, Roghi Suicide Point and Kinner Kailash views



DAY 04

Kalpa To Tabo Via Nako & Gue

The gateway into Spiti. The landscape changes completely.

200 km | 8 to 9 hrs

- Start early. Daylight matters in the mountains.
- Stop at Khab Confluence, where Sutlej meets Spiti river.
- Visit Nako Lake / Nako Village (weather permitting)
- Visit Gue Monastery and its 500-year-old preserved mummy.
- Continue to Tabo for dinner and overnight.

Overnight: Tabo | Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

Highlight: Khab, Nako and the rare Gue mummy

**DAY 05****Tabo To Dhankar, Pin Valley & Kaza**

Monasteries, cliffs, and Spiti's hidden valley.

120 km | 6 to 7 hrs

- Visit Tabo Monastery, one of Spiti's most important monasteries.
- Visit Dhankar Monastery, dramatically perched above the valley.
- Drive into Pin Valley and explore the accessible villages and viewpoints.
- Continue to Kaza for dinner and your first overnight stay.

Overnight: Kaza | Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

Highlight: Tabo Monastery, Dhankar, Pin Valley & your first Kaza evening

**DAY 06****Kaza: Langza, Hikkim, Komik**

The Postcard Day. High villages, wide skies.

- Day trip to Spiti's highest villages (route depends on conditions)
- Langza: Giant Buddha statue, valley views, marine fossils
- Hikkim: One of the highest post offices (if open)
- Komik: One of the highest villages reachable by road
- Return to Kaza by afternoon. Rest or explore the market and cafes.

Overnight: Kaza | Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

Highlight: Postcards, fossils & wide views across the high villages

**DAY 07****Kaza To Key, Chicham & Chandratal**

The big day. Monasteries, bridges, passes, lake.

- Key Monastery: Hilltop views above the Spiti River
- Kibber Village and the iconic Chicham Bridge
- Drive towards Losar and Kunzum Pass
- Cross Kunzum Pass if the road is open and safe
- Visit Chandratal after a short walk from the parking area
- One night is planned at the designated Chandratal camping zone.
- If camping or safe access is unavailable, the stay will be shifted to Losar.

Overnight: Chandratal Camp/Losar | Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

Highlight: Key, Kibber, Chicham, Kunzum Pass and Chandratal

**DAY 08****Chandratal/Losar To Manali To Delhi**

The loop closes. Through Lahaul, into the valley.

- Breakfast and check-out from Chandratal Camp or Losar.
- Drive via Batal, Chhatru and Gramphu on a rough, bumpy road.
- Cross the Atal Tunnel and reach Manali by evening.
- Take a short break depending on the Volvo departure time before boarding the overnight bus to Delhi.

Overnight: Overnight Volvo | Meals: Breakfast

Highlight: Full loop closes via Batal, Atal Tunnel and Manali

**DAY 09****Delhi Arrival. Tour Ends.**

You return, but Spiti stays with you

- Arrive Delhi in the morning (time may vary)
- Your Spiti circuit is complete.

I KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Chandratal and Kunzum Pass are seasonal. Access depends on road clearance, weather and safety on your travel date.
- If the camp is full or the group needs more comfort, you stay in a Losar hotel or guesthouse. This is confirmed in advance, and Chandratal is still visited.
- Camping is only in the marked zone near Chandratal. The protected lakeshore is visited after a short walk from the parking area.
- Chandratal camps provide basic accommodation, shared dining and limited washroom facilities. Tent allocation may differ from the hotel room-sharing option.
- Room sharing is quad, triple or double. Single rooms cost extra and depend on availability; a single Chandratal tent may not be possible.
- Groups above 10 have a trip captain. Smaller groups are supported by a coordinator and an experienced local driver.
- Pin Valley is covered on Day 5 as a drive in to the nearer villages and viewpoints. The group does not drive deep into Pin Valley on this trip.
- Some days involve long drives, especially Shimla-Sangla, Kalpa-Tabo and Chandratal-Manali. Timings are approximate.
- Spiti is high altitude. Stay hydrated, eat light, avoid alcohol and follow the acclimatisation guidance from the local team.
- Phone network becomes weak after Kaza and ATMs are unreliable. Carry enough cash for personal expenses.
- An emergency oxygen cylinder is carried in the vehicle for support purposes. Usage is chargeable and it is not a substitute for professional medical treatment.
- If you have heart, breathing or serious altitude concerns, consult your doctor before booking.
- A backup vehicle is not included. It can be arranged on request for an extra cost, subject to availability.
- All stops depend on time, daylight, weather, roads and local rules. Follow the driver and coordinator's guidance.

THINGS TO CARRY

Clothing: Layer Up

- Thermals (top and bottom): 2 to 3 sets
- Fleece or wool sweater: 1 to 2
- Down jacket or warm winter jacket (essential for Chandratat)
- Windproof / water-resistant outer layer
- Warm trekking pants: 2 pairs
- Comfortable clothes for long drives
- Socks: 5 to 6 pairs (include thick woollen for camp nights)

Footwear

- Waterproof trekking shoes with strong grip (for lake walk)
- Extra socks + optional insoles for warmth
- Slippers for hotel and camp use

Skin and Sun Protection

- Sunscreen SPF 40 to 50; reapply at altitude
- Lip balm with SPF; carry a spare
- Moisturiser + hand cream for dry mountain air

Documents and Cash

- Government photo ID + photocopy
- Enough cash for personal expenses (ATMs are unreliable after Kaza)
- Travel insurance details, if purchased

Head, Hands and Face

- Warm cap / beanie that covers ears
- Neck warmer / muffler for Chandratat
- Gloves: 1 woollen + 1 waterproof pair
- Sunglasses with UV protection for high-altitude glare

Health and Safety

- All personal medicines; do not rely on remote availability
- Basic first aid kit (band-aids, antiseptic, pain relief)
- ORS / electrolyte sachets for hydration
- Diamox only if prescribed by your doctor
- Inhaler / allergy medicines if needed

Gadgets and Essentials

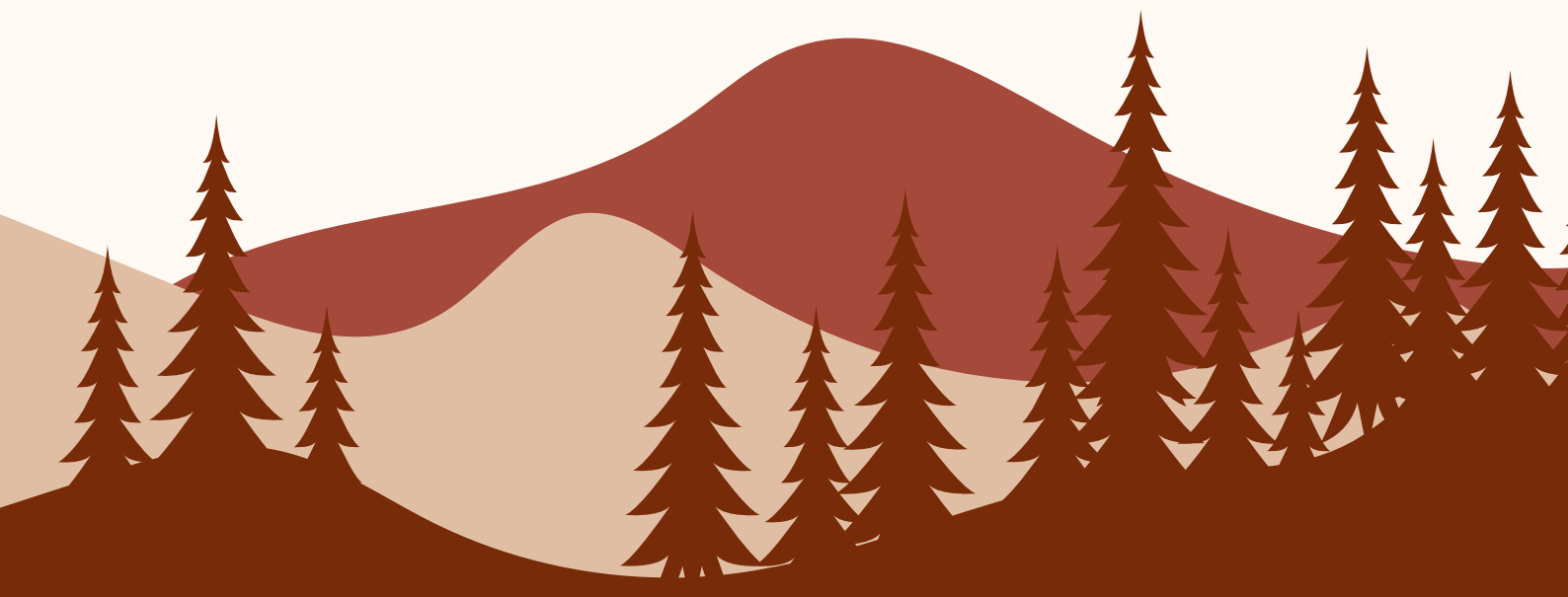
- Power bank: 10,000 to 20,000 mAh (charging is limited)
- Torch / headlamp for the camp night
- Reusable water bottle
- Toiletries + quick-dry towel
- Wet wipes + hand sanitiser for basic camp washrooms
- Small day backpack for sightseeing and lake walk

CANCELLATION POLICY

- Free cancellation of the remaining amount up to 60 days before the departure date. Booking amount is non-refundable.
- If you're cancelling the trip and opting for a refund within 59 days to 45 days of the departure date, then only 10% of the total trip cost (calculated after subtracting the booking amount), along with the booking amount (non-refundable), will be charged as a cancellation fee, and the remaining sum will be refunded.
- If you're cancelling the trip and opting for a refund within 44 days to 30 days of the departure date, then 25% of the total trip cost (calculated after subtracting the booking amount), along with the booking amount (non-refundable), will be charged as a cancellation fee, and the remaining sum will be refunded.
- If you're cancelling the trip and opting for a refund within 29 days to 16 days of the departure date, then 50% of the total trip cost (calculated after subtracting the booking amount), along with the booking amount (non-refundable), will be charged as a cancellation fee, and the remaining sum will be refunded.
